All You Need is Love dives into this astonishing body of work and will coincide with a number of 50-year Beatle anniversaries: 1969 saw the release of the Beatles' Yellow Submarine LP and Abbey Road - their 11th studio album - the group gave their final live performance on the roof of the Apple building in London's Saville Row, and John Lennon privately told the rest of the band in September that he was leaving the group.

All You Need is Love will give fans the chance to celebrate with live performances of tracks including Love Me Do, Twist and Shout, She Loves You, Eleanor Rigby, Yesterday, Hey Jude, Come Together, Let It Be and many, many more.

This electrifying multimedia spectacle will transport you back to the magical 60s when all you needed was love, and a little help from your friends!

Back in July 1967, and in the midst of the summer of love, The Beatles released the single *All You Need Is Love*. The simple message John, Paul, George and Ringo shared still stands true today. Now, backed by the National Philharmonic Concert Orchestra, **All You Need Is Love** will fill you with nostalgia and take you back to the heyday of Beatlemania.

Luke has been performing in the hit West End show *Let It Be* since 2013 as part of the original cast. He was selected to open the Broadway show at St James Theatre and played Ringo Starr for the three-month run in New York. Luke started his career as a musician on the pop scene performing with commercial artists such as Sophie Ellis-Bextor and The Feeling.

Emanuel Angeletti - Paul McCartney

In 2012 Emanuel starred in *Let It Be* in the West End and he has since been involved in many *Let It Be* tours, including Singapore, Europe and across the UK. In 1999, after many years in several bands and lots of work in recording studios, Emmanuele was chosen to become a member of Beatles band The Apple Pies. This was the start of a long series of concerts in Europe and performing on many television shows, including entering *The X Factor* in Italy in 2010.

John Brosnan - George Harrison

John is an original cast member of both the West End and Broadway productions of *Let It Be*. His first professional job at the age of 18 was playing in the orchestra pit for musical theatre before going on to record and perform in original bands in the UK and US, two of which achieved chart success, including a US Billboard hit. John has toured the world, performing as a guest artist with many of the world's leading Symphony orchestras, as well as producing and composing for short films.

Paul Canning – John Lennon

Paul landed the role of John in *Let it Be* in 2013. The part has seen him perform in London's West End at the Savoy and Garrick Theatres a European tour, Japanese Tour and Monaco's Sporting Summer Festival sharing the bill with Sir Elton John and Nile Rogers.


