Arnold Schwarzegger has led an astonishing life, from being a world champion bodybuilder, crowned Mr. Universe, to becoming one of the greatest Hollywood film stars, starring in over 50 explosive movies, a film producer, a writer, a businessman and then entering politics to become the Governor of California.

Now the global star will follow into the footsteps of Sylvester Stallone, Al Pacino and John Travolta to get up close and personal with British fans.



An Evening With Arnold Schwarzenegger will be held at the Lancaster London Hotel on Saturday 15 November. A day earlier he will take part in a black tie dinner event at The Grand Pavillion, Leeds.

If Arnold Schwarzenegger's life was a movie, it would surely be be the greatest movie ever! Born in Thal, Austria in 1947, he was soon dominating the sport of competitive bodybuilding, becoming the youngest person ever to win the Mr. Universe title at just 20. He emigrated to America and went on to win five Mr. Universe titles and seven Mr. Olympia titles before retiring to dedicate himself to acting. Later, he would go on to earn a college degree from the University of Wisconsin and became a US citizen.

Arnold soon made a name for himself in Hollywood. In 1977, the Hollywood Foreign Press Association recognised him with a Golden Globe for New Male Star of the Year for his role in Stay Hungry opposite Sally Field. His big break came in 1982 when the sword and sorcery epic, Conan the Barbarian, hit box office gold. In 1984,he blew up the screen and catapulted himself into cinema history as the title character in Jim Cameron's sci-fi thriller, Terminator. He is the only actor to be in both categories of the American Film Institute's "Hundred Years of Heroes and Villains" for roles he played in the *Terminator* series. Other memorable characters include roles in Commando, Predator, Twins, Total Recall, True Lies, Eraser, Collateral Damage, Terminator 3: Rise Of The Machines and a cameo in Sylvester Stallone's homage to action films, The Expendables and an expanded role in The Expendables 2 & 3, among others. To date, his films have grossed over \$3 billion worldwide. He served the people of California as the state's 38th Governor from 2003 to 2010. First elected in California's historic recall election, Governor Schwarzenegger ushered in an era of innovative leadership and extraordinary public service. Schwarzenegger acts as Chairman of the After School All-Stars, a nationwide after-school program, and serves as coach and international torchbearer for Special Olympics. He also served as Chairman of the President's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports under George H. W. Bush and as Chair of the California Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports under Governor Pete Wilson. Most notably, Schwarzenegger made California a world leader on renewable energy and combating climate change with the Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006, set a revolutionary political reform agenda, and became the first governor in decades to invest in rebuilding California's critical infrastructure with his Strategic Growth Plan. He also dedicated himself to promoting physical education and after-school programs, and continues to commit his time, energy and personal finances to charitable organizations around the world. Schwarzenegger recently released his autobiography, Total Recall: My Unbelievably True Life Story.

Rocco Buonvino (Promoter) has staged some of the biggest global entertainment events, from sold-out concerts to musical theatre productions and bespoke events with superstar artists. Rocco's achievements include organising and staging the world premiere of Robin Gibb's *Titanic Requiem Concert* at Westminster Central Hall and The Soldiers Charity Concert at the London Palladium. Other musical credits include promoting and staging of shows by world renowned artists such as Cliff Richard, Rod Stewart, The Chemical Brothers, Duran Duran, and the star studded Beatles Symphonica, a spectacular orchestral concert of pure classical interpretations with special star singers to celebrate the music of the world's greatest legendary band –The Beatles. Held at The Royal Albert Hall, star performers included Dame Shirley Bassey, Tony Christie, Beverley Knight and Susan Black. The latest events for this year include An Evening with Sylvester Stallone, Al Pacino and John Travolta, and now proudly presenting Mr Arnold Schwarzenegger.
