Sarah-Louise is an actress, writer, director and internationally renowned cabaret performer. She has appeared in the West End with *Julie Madly Deeply*, *Fascinating Aida*, *La Soirée* and Olivier winning improvised musical group, *The Showstoppers*. Named one of Time Out's Top 10 Cabaret Acts and voted Best Musical Variety Act in the London Cabaret Awards, she has also been nominated for an Offie and awarded The Stage Award for Acting. As well as mainstream success on television and radio, she has toured extensively, both in the UK and internationally, including three invitations to the prestigious Adelaide Cabaret Festival and a New York run. She is one half of writing and performing duo, Roulston & Young with whom she is currently creating a new musical, *Maxa, The Most Assassinated Woman In The World*.

### Russell Lucas (Director)

Russell Lucas is a London-based artist who creates work for the theatre and screen. His projects range from *Julie Madly Deeply*, to directing performance art films for Hendog Leisure. He has directed two UK premieres: *The Fat Man's Wife* by Tennessee Williams and *The Understudy* by Theresa Rebeck, as well as developing work with *The Boy With Tape On His Face*, *Sh!t Theatre*, NYC writer Roger Bennington and *Warped* at the VAULT Festival. As a passionate arts educator he delivers creative workshops for The Donmar Warehouse and for The CMK Foundation in South Korea, and has just wrapped on *Theatremakers* for Digital Theatre TV.
